Selected PV Discussion Questions:

- In your experience, how does trash management affect health, safety, or quality of life in your community?
- From what you've seen, are certain areas of Greater Hartford more impacted? Why?
- For decades trash from 70 towns has been shipped to Hartford and burned, with environmental impacts for surrounding residents. Now the plant is closed and they are considering future uses for the property. From your perspective, what should be done to make trash management and its environmental impacts more fair?
- There's some ongoing discussion about the possibility of transferring some of the remaining MIRA reserve funds to an Environmental Justice Fund that would be used to address the lingering impacts of the trash incinerator. What are your thoughts on this idea? Who should get a say in how the fund is used, and who should make the final decisions?

Debrief Questions:

- What do you hope people will take away from looking at your photograph and hearing your story?
- What did you like or dislike about using photography to share your story? Why?
- How did participating in this PhotoVoice project impact your understanding of trash management in Greater Hartford and issues of environmental justice?
